Refrigerator Energy Efficiency Labelling Training – Denmark

A delegation from South Africa led by Iqshaan Alladin (SABS Regulatory Affairs), comprising of Maphuti Lekgodi (DME), Katima Temba (SABS Regulatory Affairs), Lawrence Kuisis (Test Africa), Hennie Prinsloo (Gerotek), Isaac Mabena (SABS Commercial) and Francois du Toit (SANAS), completed a refrigerator energy efficiency labelling programme during April 2005.
