Assessment Fee	Initial Assessment for one product type(<i>e.g. CFL</i> , Double-Capped FL, Ballast,)	\$2,000
	Fee for each additional model of the same product type.	\$100 each
Certification Fee (For single trademark *)	Certification and ELI Logo usage fee for one product type(<i>e.g. CFL, Double-Capped FL, Ballast</i>)	\$2,000
	Fee for each additional model of the same product type.	\$100 each
Miscellaneous	 Miscellaneous expenses may include: a) Any expenses agreed by both parties (such as translation fee, expense of testing for and on behalf of the applicant, etc.); b) Any expenses for the ELI Quality Certification Institute's handling of the relevant complaints and disputes arising from the certified organization's service or qualified product quality. 	Shall be paid according to the amounts agreed by both parties or according to the actual expenses.

* Note: In case a certified product is sold under different trademarks, the ELI logo usage fee will be charged for each trademark, as each trademark will have to be surveyed on the market.

When the certification expires and the certification holders desire to retain their ELI certification, the full fee for Assessment, Certification and ELI Logo Usage will be charged.
