GECA Licensing Fees

GECA license fees are payable annually on the anniversary date of your Licence certificate date. The first years licence fees are payable as soon as possible after the return of the turnover declaration form to GECA, and are generated based on an estimate of first years turnover. This form will be provided to you when GECA receives the Letter of Conformance from the CAB.

These fees are to be generated based on one year's sales figures (NET sales figures, not including GST). Sales figures need to be presented on a Turnover Declaration Form and will be requested at least two months prior to due date upon the anniversary of your Licence date. The form must be submitted prior to the month your licensing fee renewal falls due.

NOTE: You are only required to provide the turnover of your GECA certified products.

This form will determine your licensing fees for the following year, the schedule of licensing fees will assist you in determining the fees that will fall due to those products certified.

- 1. Licence fees are payable up front in advance and are charged on annual basis, on the initial grant of the licence for the first year and on the anniversary of the grant of the licence each year thereafter.
- 2. You may provide an estimate of your first year's sales upon your first year of licensing if previous sales data is not available.
- 3. The product turnover is calculated in Australian Dollars and based on Australian Sales only.
